☺ **ALL JK students will have classes on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.**

☺ **JK Half-day students will arrive at 8:15 am and will be dismissed at 11:30 am**

(snack will be mid-morning, but half-day students will not need to bring a lunch).

☺ **JK Full-day students will arrive at 8:15 am and will be dismissed at 2:30 pm**

(Full-day students will need a snack and a lunch). At the 2:30 pm dismissal, parents are asked to back into their parking spot and welcomed to stay in their vehicles until students have been dismissed to go. JK – Grade 8 students are all dismissed at the same time and when all students are in their vehicles, a teacher will let parents know that all students are safely in their vehicles by signaling with a “wave”. Vehicles are then permitted to leave the parking lot.
